Notes to Editors:

- **Eden:** Privately owned and based in the City of London, Eden offers private clients independent and transparent asset management, serving the needs of high net worth individuals, families, pension funds and non-profit organisations. - **Ky Van Tang:** Ky Van has been working for Aberdeen Asset Management (UK) since June 2007. She has been responsible for investment decisions and analysis of high yield companies in the TMT sector, (Technology, Media & Telecommunications), transport services and industrials. Prior to this she worked for Aberdeen Asset Management (Australia) which she joined as an analyst in January 2002, becoming a portfolio manager in June 2003.

She is a CFA charter holder and member of the CFA Society of London having previously been awarded degrees – Bachelor of Advanced Science and Bachelor of Commerce (Majors in Advanced Pure and Applied Mathematics, Finance and Economics) – from the University of Sydney.

- **Ed Rosengarten:** Ed spent 18 years at M&G taking over as Chief Executive of Equities in 2001. His responsibilities subsequently extended to include retail fixed income in 2005 and multi-asset investing in 2007. Over this period M&G was re-established as one of the UK's leading asset management firms.
- **Mark Harris:** Mark was Head of Funds of Funds at Henderson Global Investors between 2009 and 2011, having previously worked in a similar role at New Star Asset Management from 2003 to 2009. At New Star, assets under his overall management grew from £400 million to £1.2 billion. When New Star was acquired by Henderson Group, his team of six subsequently managed over £2 billion in assets. He will jointly manage the company's existing multi-asset fund (CF Eden Global Multi-Strategy Fund), and play a leading role in developing Eden's client-focused, multi-asset product range.
- **Leigh Himsworth:** Leigh trained as an accountant, joining Price Waterhouse in 1989. After completing his MBA in 1995 he moved to Rensburg. He went to Nestlé in 1998 where he managed small and mid cap pension funds before returning to Rensburg in 2001 to manage the UK Mid-Cap Growth Trust. In 2006 he moved to Royal London Asset Management where he ran the company's UK Mid Cap Trust. In September 2009 he joined Gartmore to head up the UK equity team and managed the Gartmore UK Alpha Fund and the Gartmore UK Growth Fund.
- **Dan Roberts:** Dan qualified as an accountant with Pricewaterhouse Coopers in 1994 and subsequently worked for the company in both the UK and California. Roles at M&G and Invesco preceded his arrival at Aviva Investors in 2003 to run a £2 billion life and pensions mandate. In August 2005 he was appointed lead manager of the Aviva Investors UK Equity Income and the RBS Equity Income retail funds with combined assets of £800 million. He joined Gartmore in July 2009, to manage the Gartmore UK Equity Income Fund which he comprehensively restructured during his tenure.
